Required as soon as possible. We want to appoint a capable and positive person to work as a Cover Supervisor, and PE support worker, in our friendly community school. This post would suit someone who may, in time, be considering training to teach PE, or some other coaching/training related employment.

The role combines two key duties. Firstly, to be part of the cover team and to undertake cover supervision, where required, allocating work prepared by teachers and creating a positive working atmosphere in class, keeping students on task, and managing the behaviour of students. Secondly the successful candidate will be expected to become part of the PE team, supporting their work, and potentially taking some classes in Key Stage 3 PE as an instructor.

The successful candidate will preferably have experience of working with secondary school aged students, but not necessarily, in an education environment. They must be able to quickly learn how to operate the school management information system (Bromcom). Candidates should also have strong organisational skills, be able to work accurately, communicate effectively and exercise good interpersonal skills. An interest in, and some aptitude for sports will be necessary.

We offer a positive and supportive working atmosphere, a competitive salary and access to a contributory local government pension scheme.

31 hours per week, Monday to Friday, term time only plus 5 training days. The salary will be APT&C Grade CD (£14,102 - £14,554.92 pro rata) and SCP 1 (£3,086 pro rata) This equates to an actual salary of £17,188 - £17,640 per annum, depending on experience and service for NYCC.
