As RESET Room Coordinator, you will be responsible for coordinating the implementation and delivery of Thirsk School's RESET Room as part of the behaviour management system; ultimately contributing to a reduction in the number of students returning to isolation and being suspended from school.

You will work to ensure that high expectations of behaviour and a productive work environment are maintained, maximising the academic and personal achievement of all students whilst they are internally excluded.

You will be supported in this role by a team of people including Heads of School, Heads of Year and our Senior Leadership team.

Our ambitious school is based in the easily accessible market town of Thirsk (recently declared one of the best places to live in England) which lies very close to the A1(M), A19 and mainline rail links, between two beautiful National Parks.

Closing date for applications is **9am on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026**, with interviews to take place on **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2026**.
